The following are the definitions for the Performance Fact Sheet:

" " means the number of students who began a program who were scheduled to complete the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year and excludes all students who cancelled during the cancellation period.

" " is the number of students who began the program minus the number of students who have died, been incarcerated, or been called to active military duty.

" " is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year.

" " is the number of graduates who took the first available exam in the reported calendar year.

" " is the date for the first available exam after a student completed a program.

" " is as reported by graduate or graduate's employer.

" " is the number of graduates for whom, after making reasonable attempts, the school was not able to obtain salary information.
