

<p>Summary</p>	<p>All current University of Phoenix degree students who are actively enrolled in a University of Phoenix bachelor's degree program who (i) have taken a minimum of 24 credits at the University of Phoenix and have at least 18 credits remaining in a University of Phoenix bachelor's degree program; (ii) have an aggregate GPA of 3.75 or higher (on a 4.0 scale) in their current bachelor's degree program; (iii) have not had an unapproved break in attendance greater than 14 days in the last 365 days except for an approved leave of absence as of the scholarship deadline; and apply for this Academic Achievement Bachelor's Scholarship (Current Students) – August 2024 ("Scholarship") prior to the deadline and post attendance in a class between August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024 and August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2024 ("Initial Attendance Window") will have the opportunity to be considered for one of 15 scholarships worth up to a maximum of \$2,000 each, distributed over 20 courses.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Students must begin the admissions application prior to completing this scholarship application</p>
<p>Application Deadline</p>	<p>The Scholarship application will be made available online on August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024. Applications must be completed and submitted online at <a href="http://www.phoenix.edu">www.phoenix.edu</a> by 11:59pm MST August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2024 ("Application Deadline"). Applications submitted after the Application Deadline will not be considered. No exceptions.</p>

Eligibility Criteria

	<p>a. As part of the scholarship application, the University of Phoenix will review the applicant's official University of Phoenix student account and transcripts to verify the following requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. Applicant has completed a minimum of 24 credits at the University of Phoenix and has at least 18 credits remaining in their University of Phoenix bachelor's degree program as of the Scholarship application deadline.</li> <li>ii. Applicant has not had an unapproved attendance break of greater than 14 days in the last 365 days as of the Scholarship application deadline.</li> <li>iii. Applicant has a minimum GPA of 3.75 (on a 4.0 scale) as of the Scholarship application deadline</li> </ul> <p>Applicant must be actively enrolled and attending the University of Phoenix for a bachelor's degree program within the Initial Attendance Window.</p>
Selection Process	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The recipients of the scholarships will be selected by the University of Phoenix.</li> <li>2. It is the applicant's responsibility to submit a complete and signed application along with any required and supporting documentation, which must be received on or before the Application Deadline. The University of Phoenix accepts no responsibility for incomplete applications, applications not in proper form, lost applications, or any other submission in exception to the instructions.</li> <li>3. Scholarship selection shall be made without regard to race, color, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, age, national origin, disability, veteran status, or any other category protected by federal, state, or local law.</li> <li>4. The 15 scholarships will be awarded to the eligible applicants with the highest GPA that apply by the application deadline. In the event there are applicants with the same GPA, the applicant(s) with the earliest date of application will receive the scholarship.</li> <li>5. The decision of the University of Phoenix is final and not subject to review.</li> <li>6. Starting on September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024, the University of Phoenix will begin the selection process for eligible qualified students.</li> <li>7. Recipients will be notified no later than October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024.</li> </ol>
Scholarship Award Distribution and Timing	<p>The University of Phoenix will determine and notify the recipients of the scholarships upon validation.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The maximum scholarship award is \$2,000. The Scholarship shall be disbursed as a credit toward the student's tuition payments at a rate of \$100 per course beginning with the student's first attended course in the Initial Attendance Window and thereafter for those continuously attended courses in their bachelor's program until: (i) the student has maximized the \$2,000 Scholarship amount, or (ii) two years (730 days)</li> </ol>

2. Scholarship award is a non-cash award to recipient's University of Phoenix account as outlined on the scholarship application. Scholarship will be applied to the first credit-bearing class with a start date after the award date. No scholarship funds will be applied to previous classes or currently enrolled classes at the time of scholarship award. No check or other cash monies will be disbursed at any time. No exceptions.
