

<p>Summary</p>	<p>All new University of Phoenix bachelor's degree alumni students who (i) apply for and enroll in a University of Phoenix master's degree program; (ii) have an aggregate GPA of 3.25 or higher (on a 4.0 scale) in their University of Phoenix associate's degree; and (iii) apply for this Forever a Phoenix® Master's Scholarship – February 2024 ("Scholarship") prior to the deadline and register and post attendance in their first class between February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024 and February 29<sup>th</sup>, 2024 ("Initial Attendance Window") will have the opportunity to be considered for one of two hundred (200) scholarships worth up to a maximum of \$2,000 each, distributed over 11 courses.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Students must begin the admissions application prior to completing this scholarship application</p>
<p>Application Deadline</p>	<p>The Scholarship application will be made available online on January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024. Applications must be completed and submitted online at <a href="http://www.phoenix.edu">www.phoenix.edu</a> by 11:59pm MST February 29<sup>th</sup>, 2024 ("Application Deadline"). Applications submitted after the Application Deadline will not be considered. No exceptions.</p>
<p>Eligibility Criteria</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Applicants currently residing in the United States must meet one of the following requirements: be a legal resident of the United States; have been granted permanent residency; have a valid visa that does not prohibit educational studies; have been granted temporary protected status along with approved Notice of Action issued by Citizen Immigration Services and verified through CIS Form g-845; or have been granted asylum along with the approved Notice of Action issued by the Citizen Immigration Services.</li> <li>2. Applicant must meet all admissions requirements of University of Phoenix if selected as a scholarship recipient.</li> <li>3. Applicant must not be an employee (including full- and part-time faculty) or a family member (spouse, dependent child, or domestic partner).</li> </ol>

	<p>a. As part of the scholarship application, the University of Phoenix must receive official transcripts. Transcript/s must verify the following requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. Applicant has a bachelor degree from University of Phoenix</li> <li>ii. Applicant had a minimum GPA of 3.25</li> <li>iii. Official transcripts must be received, and the applicant must be officially evaluated and fully admitted into the University of Phoenix by the last date of their first registered course.</li> </ul> <p>Applicant must post attendance to their first master's degree course within the Initial Attendance Window.</p>

Selection Process

1. The recipients of the scholarships will be selected by the University of Phoenix.
2. It is the applicant's responsibility to submit a complete and signed application along with any required and supporting documentation, which must be received on or before the Application Deadline. The University of Phoenix accepts no responsibility for incomplete applications, applications not in proper form, lost applications, or any other submission in exception to the instructions.
3. Scholarship selection shall be made without regard to race, color, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, age, national origin,

6. The Scholarship will automatically terminate if:
  - a. Applicant fails to meet the eligibility requirements
  - b. Recipient is Academically Disqualified, Disqualified for Admission, Scholastically Disqualified, Scholastically Suspended or Expelled as outlined in the University Catalog.
  - c. Recipient is out of attendance on an unapproved leave of absence for more than 35 days.
  - d. Recipient completes their master's degree program.
  - e. Receives the maximum scholarship award
  - f. Two years (730 days) from the start date of recipient's first course notwithstanding any approved leave of absence(s).

If recipient has applied for or is receiving Title IV financial aid funding, this scholarship may reduce the recipient's eligibility for Title IV financial aid funding to comply with Title IV regulations. In addition, the recipient and family are responsible for any Title IV funds received by the University of Phoenix and/or must qualify for a leave of absence to maintain his/her financial aid status.
