

<p>Summary</p>	<p>All new students or students who have been out of attendance for over 365 days who i) apply for and enroll in a University of Phoenix master's degree program; (ii) have three year's work experience and (iii) apply for this Phoenix Master's Winter Scholarship – January 2023 ("Scholarship") prior to the deadline and register and post attendance in their first class between January 1st, 2023 and January 31st, 2023 ("Initial Attendance Window") will receive a scholarship up to \$3,000 each.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Students must begin the admissions application prior to completing this scholarship application</p>
<p>Application Deadline</p>	<p>The Scholarship application will be made available online on December 7th, 2022. Applications must be completed and submitted online at www.phoenix.edu by 11:59pm MST January 31st, 2023 ("Application Deadline"). Applications submitted after the Application Deadline will not be considered. No exceptions.</p>
<p>Eligibility Criteria</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Applicants currently residing in the United States must meet one of the following requirements: be a legal resident of the United States; have been granted permanent residency; have a valid visa that does not prohibit educational studies; have been granted temporary protected status along with approved Notice of Action issued by Citizen Immigration Services and verified through CIS Form g-845; or have been granted asylum along with the approved Notice of Action issued by the Citizen Immigration Services. 2. Applicant must meet all admissions requirements of University of Phoenix if selected as a scholarship recipient. 3. Applicant must not be an employee (including full- and part-time faculty) or a family member (spouse, dependent child, or domestic partner) of an employee of University of Phoenix or any other affiliate of University of Phoenix, Inc. 4. Applicant must apply and be admitted to a University of Phoenix master's degree program. 5. Applicant must submit a complete, signed application, together with all supporting documentation by the Application Deadline. The completion of the application form does not create an obligation to award a scholarship to the applicant.
